Following the last bulletin, a number of residents volunteered to look after the tubs and flower beds in the village. They have some good ideas, which are looking to the future, not just this first year, so we wanted to let everyone know about the plans.

The residents involved so far are Joyce, Paul, and Colin. They are in the process of getting tubs and planters sorted out, and making plans. This year, they are going to buy plug plants, but starting next year, they plan to grow the plants from seed, making use of the polytunnel behind Jim's container.



When we looked at the tunnel, we realised it was in poor condition, so we investigated repairing and renewing options. The best solution was to renew it, so one has been ordered, and work has begun to tidy up the area, and sort out the trays, pots etc which will be needed.



The big oak tree, which is due to be felled, is quite close to the polytunnel, so we plan to coordinate the removal of the old tunnel, the tree felling, and the installation of the new tunnel, to ensure nothing is damaged.
