

Bulletin No 14 Tennis Court Padlock

We have decided to restrict access to the village tennis court by use of a combination padlock. All village residents will have the combination number. In the past the court was padlocked with a key, available from the CMCL secretary. There are a number of reasons why we have decided to do this.



Firstly there is currently an issue of moss growing on parts of the surface of the court, and when wet this poses a hazard of slips and falls. Jim has applied moss killer to try to resolve this problem, and a sign has been placed at the entrance to the court highlighting these risks. However, we think it prudent to control access with the use of the padlock. Anyone entering the court by unlocking the padlock accepts responsibility for their own safety, and the safety of anyone with them, recognising the possible hazards within.

A second reason to use the padlock is to ensure it is only the residents of Crambeck Village, and their friends and family, who can use this facility. We, as a village, have to maintain the court, and any damage or maintenance costs come out of our funds, so it is only right that its use is restricted. The combination for the padlock is currently 1966. The number will be changed from time to time, and the new number will be advised immediately in one of the bulletins.



The padlock will be used from 6th May. Please re-fix the padlock and scramble the numbers when you leave the court.
