

Bulletin No 18 Paddocks

Since the last horses left in 2014, the paddocks have been used for dog walking, and we have had to maintain them. Last year we were late organising the weed killing, which meant it wasn't completely successful, but the mowing, which followed, made a good job, and set up the paddocks for the winter.

This year, we organised the spraying earlier, so we caught the weeds at the ideal time. Of course, the paddocks had to be closed to dog walkers during this time, as a precaution.



Recently, Richard has mowed the paddock nearest to the gas tanks, and this is now open again for dog walking. Thanks Richard! Please make sure you pick up after your dog, and put it in the nearby bin.

The other paddock, next to the A64, has not been mowed because we are expecting some horses to arrive in the next few weeks. The horses do not belong to a resident, but while no residents want to use the grazing, we think it is reasonable to rent the paddock to someone from elsewhere.



Anyone renting the paddock has to sign an agreement, with strict conditions for its maintenance.

Feel free to walk your dogs in the first paddock, while the horses are in the other one, but please make sure your dogs are under control, and do not disturb the horses!
