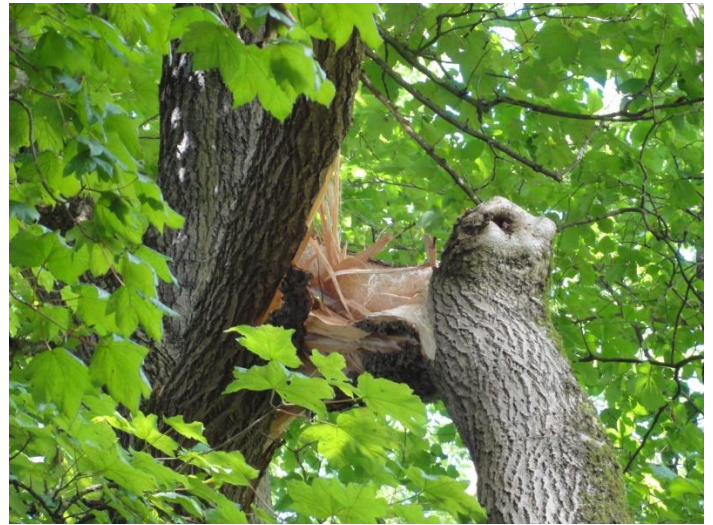


## Bulletin No 31 Hazard on riverside path

A large branch has come down onto the riverside path, just before the second fence, and it is hanging rather precariously from the break, high in the tree.



There is a risk that it will all come down, so as a matter of precaution we have put up a “Footpath closed temporarily” sign, and we encourage you not to pass under the branch until it has been made safe. The break is too high in the tree for us to deal with it, so we have contacted a tree surgeon, and hope he will get it down in the next week or so. As soon as it is safe, Jim and Peter will clear up, we will re-open the path, and let everyone know.

Meanwhile, the first section of the path has recently become obstructed by bracken falling onto the mown strip. We will clear this when the tree has been made safe, as part of the tidying up operation. Next year, Peter is planning to mow a wider path on this part, to avoid the obstruction developing.
